



**golf el rompido** welcomes you to its facilities and is pleased to advise you of certain regulations to enable you to enjoy to the full your stay at our complex.

We kindly request that you adhere to these at all times in a sportsmanlike manner, in the spirit of this wonderful sport.

## THE CLUBHOUSE

### 1 Access

Access to the Clubhouse at golf el rompido is free and open to everyone.

Those under 16 years of age must be accompanied at all times by an adult, who shall be responsible for ensuring that they do not run around or cause any disturbance to other Guests.

### 2 Dress code

No swimwear, bare feet or bare torsos are permitted in the Clubhouse.

### 3 Opening hours

The opening hours vary according to the time of year and the hours of daylight; the Clubhouse will always be open at least 15 minutes prior to the 1<sup>st</sup> round of golf

## THE COURSES

### 1 Access

In order to access the courses, you will need to be in possession of a green fee ticket which you can obtain from the Clubhouse reception desk. You will be asked for this by the Marshall during your round.

Failure to carry this ticket on your person may result in your being asked to leave the course.

### 2 Dress code

You shall be required to wear appropriate golf clothing on the courses.

Golf el Rompido does not allow the following garments on the courses:

T-shirts

jeans

swimwear or casual shorts

Specific golf footwear or flat-soled sports footwear must be worn.

We recommend the use of sun cream all year round.



### 3 Opening times and rounds.

The opening time in the morning is determined by the first round and the closing time is determined by the hours of daylight (in winter) or by the starting of the watering systems in summer.

### 4 Playing Time

The playing time is without doubt the most difficult area to manage in a Golf complex.

The actual playing time is determined by the groups who are playing; thank you for your cooperation in maintaining a pleasant pace for everyone.

1. One hole is played in an average of 15 minutes; a group of 4 players should complete a round of 18 holes in 4 hrs 34 min maximum.
2. Please be at the starting tee 5 minutes before your start time.
  - a. Remember that delays at the start will accumulate throughout the day and delay other starts.
  - b. On the North course, allow 5 extra minutes to reach tee 1
3. Always keep to your start time and to the group arranged.
4. If you believe your ball may be lost, always play a provisional ball.
5. Always allow the group behind you to play through if it is playing faster than yours; please remember that a group of 3 players takes priority over a group of 4, and one of 2 players over one of 3. A lone player has no priority.
6. On the edge of the Green, always leave your bag or clubs on the way to the next Tee.
7. Please follow the instructions of the Marshall at all times.

### RESPECTING THE COURSE AND THE ENVIRONMENT

1. Please replace divots, repair ball marks and rake bunkers; you will appreciate this on your next visit.
2. Do not pick flowers or plants; 75% of the perimeter of the course is a protected natural site.
3. The use of buggies damages the courses; always keep to the paths, the rough and well away from the greens and tees at all times.
4. Do not drive along banks or any wetland areas.
5. Do not throw cigarette ends or scraps of paper onto the course; please use the 50 rubbish bins provided around the course for this purpose.
